Museum gets help with capital improvements

Geneseo—A \$21,750 check was recently presented to the Geneseo Historical Museum by the GIFT Foundation. “These funds are from the Bill and Susan Sherrard Trust,” says GIFT Foundation Chairman Brett Lohman.

Museum Curator Angie Snook said that the funds are earmarked for capital improvements. “We need a new heating and cooling system and major repairs to our roof,” she said. “This will go a long way in getting that done.”
