Geneseo Students Benefit from \$40,000 gift

Geneseo—The Geneseo Endowment for Excellence in Education (G.E.E.E.) recently received a check for \$40,000 from the Geneseo Is For Tomorrow Foundation (GIFT). The funds are from the Bill and Susan Sherrard Trust.
